GRUNDY CENTER COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT January 20, 2021

The Grundy Center Community School District Board of Education met in regular session on Wednesday, January 20, 2021 at 5:00 pm at the Western Outreach Center.

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 pm.

Motion made by Director Martens, seconded by Director Yoder to approve the Agenda. Motion carried unanimously 3-0.

President Gordon welcomed visitors.

Motion made by Director Yoder, seconded by Director Martens to approve the Consent Agenda approving the minutes from the 12-16-20 Regular Meeting, 12-16-20 Work Session, bills presented for payment, personnel requests and open enrollments. Motion carried unanimously 3-0.

The board was given an opportunity to review the department reports prepared by Mr. Sammons, Mr. Vokes, Mr. Breyfogle and Mr. Wagner.

ITEMS FOR CONSIDERATION:

Motion made by Director Yoder, seconded by Director Martens to approve the first reading of Policy Primers Volume 29 #2. Motion carried unanimously 3-0.

Motion made by Director Martens, seconded by Director Yoder to approve the first and waived second reading of Policy Primers Volume 29 #3. Motion carried unanimously 3-0.

Motion made by Director Martens, seconded by Director Yoder to allow the Superintendent authority to grant Family Sick Leave, Personal Leave or a special leave to cover a staff member that may run out of all appropriate leave due to a Covid-19 leave of absence. Motion carried unanimously 3-0.

The board did an exercise to

narrow down the District Goals through 2025. The results found that the top 4 areas they would like to focus are: student testing/ACT scores, community development including the "Kids Campus", facility improvements in the middle/high school including the sports complex concessions/bathrooms/ticket entry, and increased board interaction with administrators.

Superintendent Hughes updated the board on school dynamics and absence with covid-19. We continue to have low absenteeism from school contact and we have 17 students distance learning.

The Board reviewed the upcoming dates to remember.
